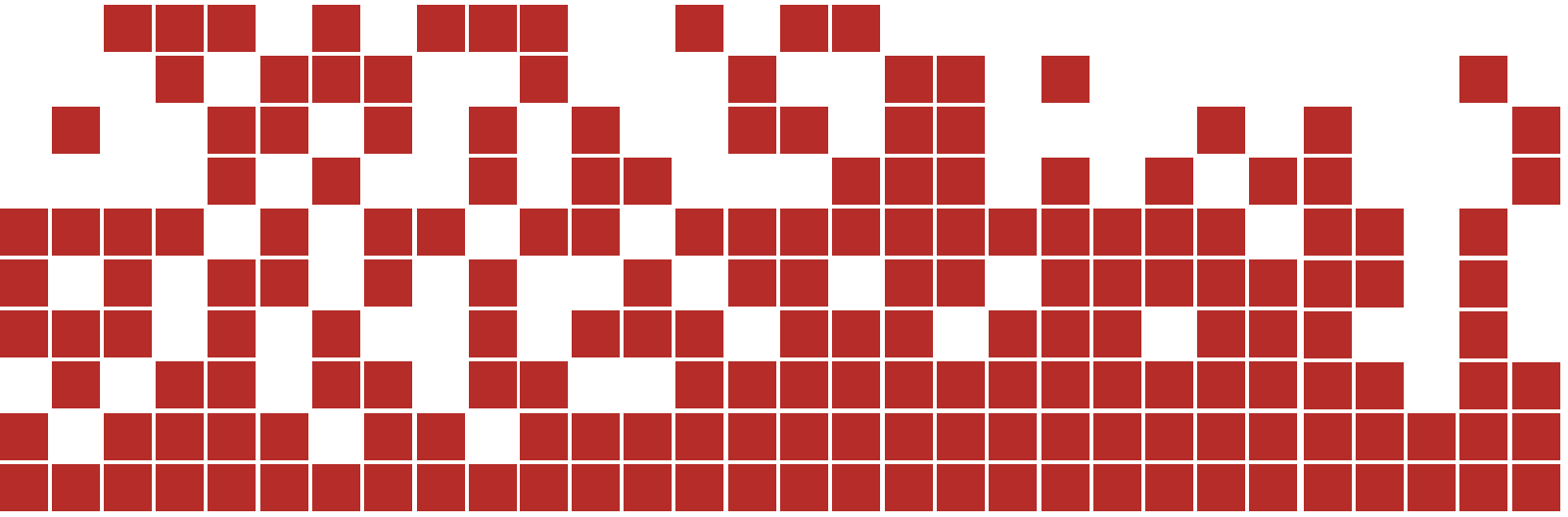

**In addition to this application, students are asked to submit the following data:**

- 1. Three letters of recommendation.**
- 2. Entering freshman and students who have completed less than 30 hours of college credit need to provide a copy of their high school transcript and a copy of ACT or SAT scores**
- 3. Students who have completed at least 12 hours of college credit need to provide an official transcript from each college attended which includes grades from the most recent semester completed.**
- 4. One billfold size picture in original form for publishing in various publications. No Selfies! Selfies and/or facebook photos will not be accepted.**
  - ❖ **Students must be enrolled on a full-time basis to be eligible to apply – 12 credit hours as an undergraduate, 6 credit hours as a graduate**
  - ❖ **Students must have a minimum 2.50 grade point average to be eligible to apply.**
  - ❖ **Scholarships are available for attendance at accredited state supported universities, private universities, junior colleges, or vocational schools.**
  - ❖ **Seven scholarships will be awarded for \$2,500 each, payable at \$1,250 per semester. After completion of first semester, student must present to Opportunity Plan, Inc. proof of maintaining a minimum 2.50 GPA to receive the additional \$1,250.**
  - ❖ **RBEC will give one scholarship to a person attending the following schools:**

  - ❖ **An additional At-Large Scholarship will be awarded to those not attending the above mentioned schools.**
  - ❖ **Additionally, applicants not chosen from their prospective school will also be reconsidered for any scholarship that is not applied for.**
  - ❖ **Scholarship money will be advanced to the prospective school contingent upon meeting the enrollment status of full time.**
