In addition to this application, students are asked to submit the following data:

- 1. Three letters of recommendation.
- 2. Entering freshman need to provide a copy of their high school transcript and a copy of ACT or SAT scores
- Students who have completed at least 12 hours of college credit need to provide an official transcript from each college attended which includes grades from the most recent semester completed.
- 4. One billfold size picture in original form for publishing in various publications.

Criteria

- ❖ Students must be enrolled on a full-time basis to be eligible to apply − 12 credit hours as an undergraduate, 6 credit hours as a graduate
- **Students must have a minimum 2.50 grade point average to be eligible to apply.**
- Scholarships are available for attendance at accredited state supported universities, private universities, junior colleges, or vocational schools.
- ❖ Seven scholarships will be awarded for \$3,000 each, payable at \$750 per semester for 2 years. After completion of first semester, student must present to the Opportunity Plan, Inc. proof of maintaining a minimum 2.50 GPA.
- **❖** Vocational scholarships, will be payable at \$1,500 upon proof of enrollment and \$1,500 after completion certification provided to the Opportunity Plan.
- **RBEC** will give one scholarship to a person attending the following schools:

Hartley Dumas
Dalhart Stratford
Texline Sunray

- ❖ An additional At-Large Scholarship will be awarded.
- **❖** Additionally, applicants not chosen from their prospective school will also be reconsidered for any scholarship that is not applied for.
- Scholarship money will be advanced to the prospective school contingent upon meeting the enrollment status of full time.
